Subject: RE: Proposed Delineation of Area for the Resident Representative Election (2011-2014)

Dear C, I met Spender in the North District office several days ago. He explained the reasonable and lawful process for the Luk Keng name issue. Basically, the government need to assure the Wong ethnic groups being able to has a representative in the lawful voting. That's why there is Wong Uk and Chan Uk generated in Luk Keng by law. Such an approach was fully agreed by all the Luk Keng representatives in the 2003-2007 voting practice. Presently, the Wong ethnic group has no argument for living in Chan Uk; achingly the previous representatives give improper explanation to the Chan ethnic group for living in Wong Uk. Spender said that the village map and district separation is for the present village only, but not for the indigenous inhabitant. However, when I reviewed the Village Representative Election Ordinance (Chapter 576), Luk Keng Wong Uk and Luk Keng Chan Uk do exist in the present village and the I.I. village. Practically, the public administration is basic on such separation. A solid example is that a Mr. Chan of Chan Uk, was rejected his small house application in Wong Uk with such a reason by the Lands Department. I do agree with the government to assure Wong ethnic group has Wong Representative forever under the law. Nevertheless, I cannot accept the I.I. benefits under the Basic Law are interrupted by such a separation. The government has the unshirkable responsibility to clear up the technical troubles under the Law Chapter 576. For the last few days, government has repeated to our people the procedure for renaming the current village name. Sincerely, the government is not easy to handle such a hot potato. Regards, WH
